2. Document Notes:

See Constitutional Rule 42 for rules about the process to make exceptions, changes or otherwise for the implementation of By-Laws. The purpose of these bylaws is to address specific details regarding the management of the group based on the purpose and setup of the group.

3. Membership status

3.1 Membership register

For the purposes of the members register, the "members list" within the QLUG Inc. website, based on member subscription signup shall serve as a register for the member class of social paid and social unpaid. Paid members who choose not to be signed up on the website shall have their details recorded as per section 13 of the Constitutional Rules. Being a part of the QLUG Community group on Facebook is NOT classed as being a registered member of QLUG Inc. as no details are obtained when joining the Facebook group.

3.2 Membership subscriptions

3.2.1 Members need to maintain their signup status on the website to remain members. This is to ensure members are active and contact details remain up to date.

3.2.2 Paid members need to maintain card details so their automatic subscription payment can be processed.

3.2.3 Free members renew their subscription upon expiry.

3.3 Any member who does not fulfill the requirements to keep their membership active will be recorded as such and will be removed from email lists and no longer considered a member as per constitutional rule 10.3 clause C.

4. Ambassador:

The role of LEGO Ambassador serves as the primary administrative channel between The LEGO Group (TLG) and QLUG.

To be eligible to nominate for the role, a member must hold and maintain a paid Membership for the year of their nomination.

Before nominating for the role, an eligible candidate must agree to:

1. Maintain an active presence on the designated LAN channels/services, including meetings and consultation requests.
2. Report to the Committee and Club any news or policy changes from TLG as they refer to QLUG.
3. Promptly report Club activities back to TLG as required.
4. Coordinate the LUGBulk Program on behalf of QLUG, when participating.
5. Adhere to the guidelines on behaviour, content and confidentiality as set by TLG

5. LUGBulk:

5.1 The LUGBulk Program is run by The LEGO Group. QLUG is permitted access to the program through continued qualification as a Recognised LUG. The purpose of the LUGBulk Program is to supply LUG members with discounted Bulk parts to be used for creating public displays or for their private collections.

5.2 LUGBulk Participation is open to QLUG members with a current paid membership. Participation in the program is not guaranteed yearly due to minimum participation requirements that need to be met and will be evaluated on a year by year basis.
